


Important Dates


- Thursday August 18, 10:00 am: pre-SOQ meeting


Flood Control District Zones




- Updates to the existing Drainage Master Plans for Zones 3A and 6
- New Drainage Master Plans for Zones 2, 2A, 4, 5, 9, and 13 building on existing watershed studies




- Conditions assessments to catalogue and inventory the physical condition of select District facilities
- Hydrology and hydraulics analyses for specific projects to support the District's capital improvement program



- Preliminary plans, specifications, and estimates for select projects
- Review, identify and document potential impacts to District infrastructure that would result from proposed third party projects



• Apply for and manage applicable grants to augment District project funding

- Relevant experience

- Financial responsibility
